Handmade and purchase for resale products cannot be grouped together. No exceptions. Items purchased for resale must apply as a commercial vendor.*

Commercial (non-craft) Vendors: *All items displayed must be new items purchased for resale. The sale of stink bombs, silly string, colored hairspray, and any other projectile items, including marshmallow guns, is prohibited. Yard sale/flea market items (used items) or weapons of any type are not allowed. If prohibited items are being sold, the People Fest Committee has the right to remove violators immediately from the festival. There will be no refund of fees, and violators will not be invited to participate in future festivals.*

Non-Profit and Commercial Food Vendors: *Non profit food vendors must provide and attach documentation of 501 status with application. Food vendors are approved on a “first come first serve” basis to avoid having too many vendors selling similar items. Food vendors may sell any type of beverage except alcoholic beverages. The Town of Wadesboro enforces all state regulations regarding food preparation and procedures. Once notified of your acceptance as a food vendor, you must contact the Anson County Health Department to receive a permit.*
